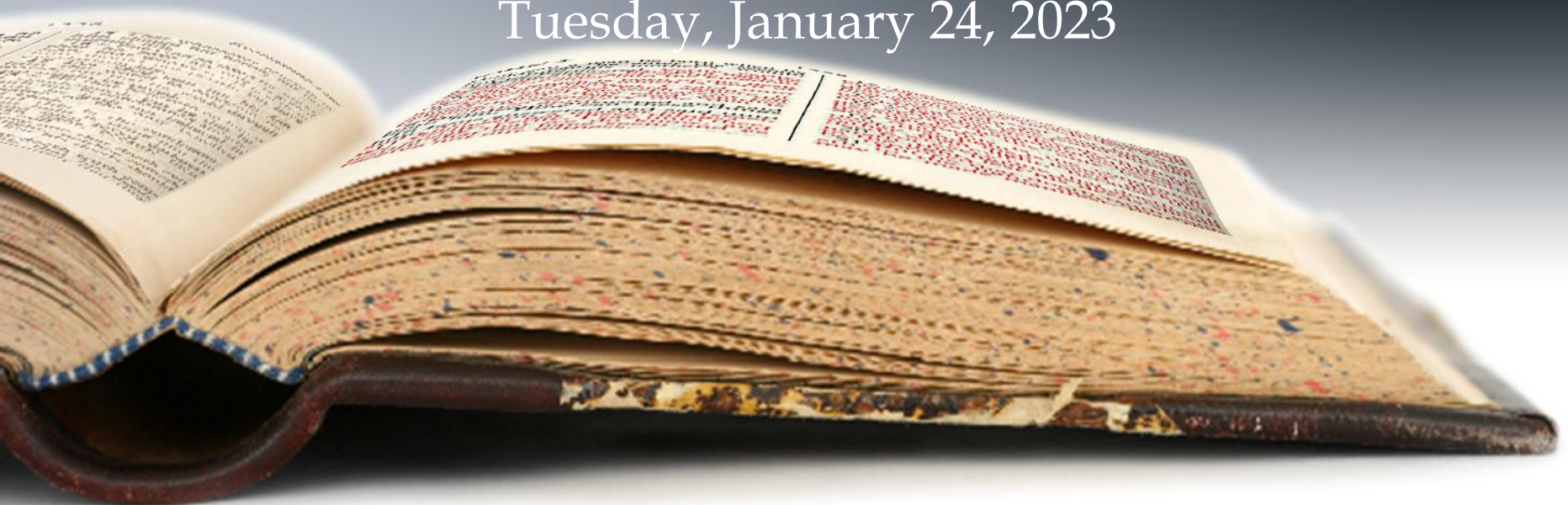

Choose Jesus Christ as Lord



Some choose esteemed persons to serve or an authority figure: a pastor, a professor, a politician.

Some choose a close relative as their ultimate authority.

Some people serve a mission or an organization.

Some people serve a personal agenda.

He is the firstborn of all creation.



Firstborn came to mean
“unique in rank and privilege.”



Israel is my firstborn.

Exodus 4:22



But you are a chosen people,
a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's
special possession, that you may declare
the praises of him who called you out
of darkness into the marvelous light.

1 Peter 2:9



Jesus is the firstborn over all creation.
He holds the highest rank because
he is the creator of all things.



He was with God in the beginning.
Through him all things were made;
without him nothing was made that
has been made.

John 1:2-3

The word head is to be understood
as “origin” or “authority.”



Jesus is Lord! There is nothing outside the scope of Christ's sovereignty. Since all things natural and supernatural were created through him, they are subject to his authority.
