
Psalm 103:1-12

The Message Bible



He forgives your sins – every one.
He heals your diseases – every one.
He redeems you from hell – saves your
life. He crowns you with love and
mercy – a paradise crown.

Psalm 103:3



God is sheer mercy and grace; not easily angered,
he's rich in love. He doesn't endlessly nag
and scold, nor does he hold grudges forever. He
doesn't treat us as our sins deserve, nor pay us
back for our wrongs. As high as heaven is over
the earth, so strong is his love to those who fear him.

Exodus 34:6-7a




Jesus was the lamb of God
