







The omniscient, all-knowing God is our instructor, our teacher, who has provided us with everything we need for life and godliness.

Some folks treat the Word like a seat belt.




Some treat the Word like it is a foreign language they do not understand.



Principles – general guidelines that require discernment and maturity if we are going to grasp them.




The commands of the Lord are radiant, giving light to the eyes.
